

Tips & Hints

STOPPING DISTANCES

If you don't happen to have a modern bike which is fitted with ABS then this poster is to serve as a reminder of the stopping distances.

The majority of experts agree that roughly 70 percent of braking effort should be directed to the front wheel, which uses the hand lever on the right grip, and 30 percent to the rear, which is operated by the right foot pedal.



Today many scooters, touring bikes, cruisers, and sport bikes are equipped with linked brakes. They are designed to activate both front and rear brakes through a single lever. However some systems are only rear-to-front linked, while others work both ways, but the aim is the same with both methods. To remove some of the bikers guesswork involved with choosing between the front and rear brakes. While a majority of bike riders just can't stop at distances as short as those created by the modern linked braking systems.
